Enter the 2010 Women's Greater Cleveland Amateur Championship, to be played at Sleepy Hollow Golf Course on Saturday July 31<sup>st</sup> and Sunday August 1<sup>st</sup>. This 36-hole stroke play tournament will be contested at scratch, and is open to amateur golfers of any age or residence. Contestants are expected to have a current handicap index of 18.4 or less in order to reasonably compete. USGA rules govern all play.

### Championship Schedule

The Women's Greater Cleveland Amateur Championship will be contested over 36 holes at stroke play. All players will play Saturday and Sunday beginning at approximately 8 a.m. Tee times may have to be adjusted based the size of the field. In the event of inclement weather the Women's Championship may be shortened to 18 holes.

### Entry

All players shall enter using an official entry form. Entry fees are \$70, which includes the green fees. Carts are optional and not included in the entry fee. Caddies and spectators are welcome.

### **Eligibility**

Competitors are expected to have a current handicap index of 18.4 or less in order to reasonably compete. A USGA handicap index is not required for entry to this event.

Entries are subject to rejection at any time (including during the Championship and Qualifying) by the Tournament Committee. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

### **Rules of Golf; Close of Competition**

Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA. Questions will be resolved by the Tournament Committee, whose decision will be final. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the Championship trophy has been presented.

### **Golf Balls; Driver Heads**

Only brands of golf balls on the current USGA List of Conforming Golf Balls and driver heads on the most current USGA List of Conforming Driver Heads may be used. This list may be found on the USGA website at [www.usga.org](http://www.usga.org). The so-called "One-Ball Rule", the optional condition prescribed in Appendix I of the Rules of Golf, shall **not** be in effect.

### **Distance Measuring Devices**

During a stipulated round of this competition a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to measure other conditions that might affect his play (gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

The distance between any two objects on the course is considered public information and not advice.

### **Tee Times/Time of Starting**

Players should contact the course starting the Tuesday before play to obtain tee times. The optional condition for time of starting prescribed in Appendix I of the Rules of Golf shall be in effect.

### **Weather**

In the event of inclement weather the Women's GCAC may be shortened to 18 holes.

### **Caddies**

Competitors may provide their own caddie. No caddies are available at the course. Caddies may rent a golf cart; however only two carts will be allowed on the course with each group and the players have priority on using a cart. A player is not required to employ a caddie for any stage of the Championship.

### **Transportation**

Rental carts are available for use during the tournament. Only two carts are allowed for each group. Players within a group must decide the users of any carts. A caddie or spectator may ride in a cart if the players are not using it.

### **Spectators**

During the tournament spectators are welcome. Spectators are responsible for their own safety while on the golf course.

### **Prizes**

The winner of The Women's Championship will receive the 2010 Women's Greater Cleveland Amateur Championship trophy. The top finishers will be awarded merchandise certificate prizes. The amount of the prizes will depend on the number of entries. In the event of ties, a playoff immediately after the conclusion of play will be held to determine the Champion; all other prize amounts will be split among the ties.
