Academy of Golf Instruction

Cleveland Metroparks *Academy of Golf* offers classes to help junior golfers advance his/her skills. There are “Fun”damentals classes for basic skill building, and classes and leagues where parents can learn and play golf with their child. See the *Academy of Golf* section on the website for details.

Junior Clinic One-Day Super Clinic

A one-day clinic will be hosted at Washington Golf Course on Friday, June 8th from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. This hands-on clinic will feature lessons on the full swing, pitching, and putting. Appropriate for brand new beginners through early intermediate skill players. Advanced registration with \$10 payment required.

Junior Clinics Three-Day

These three-day, 75 minute per day clinics, similar to the Super Clinic, cover topics a bit more in-depth and include some golf rules and etiquette. Advanced registration with \$20 payment required. Participation is limited.

Pee-Wee Leagues

These three-hole entry level leagues are designed to introduce new players to the on-course golf experience. Each foursome must have a parent or adult to walk along to supervise their children’s safety and play.

6 to 10 years old (age guideline)

\$10 registration. No weekly greens fee.

Three holes per week for five weeks; June - July

East side - Shawnee Hills Par-3, Friday mornings

West side - Mastick Woods, Thursday mornings

Cadet Leagues

These are transitional leagues for players ready for more than the three-hole Pee-Wee League but not quite ready for a full course experience. 8 to 13 years old (age guideline)

\$20 registration. Weekly junior greens fee Shawnee Par 3 and Mastick Woods - \$6.50

9-holes per week for 8 weeks; Mid-June to early August

East side – Shawnee Hills Par-3 Monday

West side – Mastick Woods Tuesday

A Cadet League with instruction is offered at Washington Golf Course on Monday mornings. \$110 covers the green fees, instruction, and range balls.

Junior Leagues

These leagues are designed for intermediate skill players mature enough to handle 9-holes of regulation golf on their own. 11 to 17 years old (age guideline)

\$20 registration. East side weekly junior greens fee - \$9.50

West side weekly junior greens fee - \$7.50

9-holes per week for 8 weeks; June - August

East side - Shawnee Hills –Tuesdays at 10 a.m.

West side - Little Met – Thursdays at 9:30 a.m.

Advanced Junior League

This league is designed for the serious junior golfer with skills advanced enough to score below 50 on a regular basis on a regulation golf course. A junior league player from the previous season should have a league handicap of 12 or less to participate.

12 to 17 years old (age guideline)

\$20 registration. Weekly junior greens fee - \$9.50

9-holes per week for 8 weeks. League championship is 18-holes; mid-June – late July

West side - Big Met – Mondays at 11 a.m.

Fee includes green fees, hand carts, instruction, and range balls.

Yes, there is some free golf for juniors! On the three major summer holidays; Memorial Day, July 4th, and Labor Day, after 1 p.m., there is a free round of golf for a junior, age 17 and under, with a paid adult fee.

Clubs for Kids

Used clubs have been donated to Cleveland Metroparks by various generous organizations and individuals. Applicants must register and be measured. Clubs are cleaned, cut down to size, and re-gripped. Two to five weeks should be allowed for orders. The cost is \$7 per club (tax included). Applicants generally receive a set. A set consists of four to seven clubs depending on the height of the child. Clubs are appropriate for new and still-growing young junior golfers ages 5 to 17 years old. Since sets are not necessarily matched, Clubs-for-Kids are not suitable for advanced players.

**Junior Day
Camps**

These five day camps for young golfers (ages 8 to 17) will include instruction, etiquette, rules, and playing on the golf course. Juniors should bring a packed lunch. The fee for the week of camp, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., is \$200. Extended care is available for children arriving at 8 a.m. and staying until 5 p.m. A fee of \$25 covers extended care for the entire week. A lunch option is available at Seneca for \$25/week.

The camps are offered weekly June 11 thru August 10, at both Washington and Seneca Golf Courses.
